Linnaeus University: Facts and figures

- 1th of January 2010
- Merge between Växjö University and University of Kalmar
- 31 000 students
- 15 000 FTE
- 2 000 employees
- 138 programmes
- Several hundred subjects
- Turnover SEK 1 500 million, whereof 350 million research



University Library: Research services as a strategic factor

- Work for a research-orientated library
- Improve opportunities for contacts and dialogue
- Needs-orientated services
- Establish new ways to deliver services – project participation and co-operationen
- The University Library as a Symbol



University Library: The infrastructural hostmanship

- **The library as a host for research projects- an alliance between core and support activities**
- Project management. Co-ordination and leading, administration, meetings
- Operational activities. Publishing strategy guidance, Information specialist support (library staff), Digitization
- Infrastructure. Project premises, dedicated computer facilities

- Electronic publishing in the research database LIBRIS of a supplement to the national edition of the Swedish medieval ballads/Nätpublicering i forskningsdatabasen LIBRIS av supplementband till utgåvan av Sveriges medeltida ballader
